AWARDS AND RECOGNITION

SENIOR ATHLETICS AWARD BANQUET

The importance of recognizing the contributions made by student-athletes at Saint Peter's College can not be overlooked. The sacrifices made to compete at this level will be recognized with a Senior Athletics Award Banquet that will be held in the first week of May each year. All individuals who have completed their intercollegiate eligibility will be invited to attend the banquet.

Awards are as follows:

- 1-year participant in intercollegiate athletics = Certificate.
- 2-year participant in intercollegiate athletics = Plaque.
- 3-year participant in intercollegiate athletics = Pen / Pencil Set.
- 4-year participant in intercollegiate athletics = Watch.

Invitations to attend the annual banquet will be sent out to all student-athletes meeting the criteria above in late March. Additional invitations will be sent to: President of the College, Vice President for Student Affairs, Dean of Students, Recreational Life Center Administrative Staff, Maintenance Department, all Athletics Coaches and Staff Members, Faculty Moderators and the NCAA Faculty Athletics Representative and others as deemed by the Director of Athletics.

Student-athletes may elect to have parents / family members attend the banquet. Guests of the student-athletes must pay for the meal and activities as determined by costs on a yearly basis.

The Sports Information Director will serve as the Master of Ceremonies at the banquet; coaches will be prepared to speak about their representative seniors and distribute the award(s).

A male and female student-athlete of the year will be named and recognized. This award is based on their athletic and academic abilities and achievements throughout their athletic and academic careers.

STUDENT-ATHLETE HONOR ROLL

The Academic / Athletic Coordinator will develop the Student-Athlete Honor Roll after each semester. The Honor Roll will include all student-athletes that have obtained a grade point average of 3.0 and higher. In addition, the top 10 female and top 10 male student-athletes will be identified and listed as well as the top 5 teams with the highest cumulative grade point average.

OTHER AWARDS AND RECOGNITION

There are many other team and individual awards and honors that a student-athlete can be nominated for. They include but are not limited to: All-MAAC Teams, All-MAAC Academic Teams, MAAC Player of the Week, MAAC Rookie of the Week, ECAC awards, GTE Academic All-Americans, N.J.A.I.A.W. Female Student-Athlete, New Jersey State teams and honors, NCAA Post Graduate Scholarships, NCAA Female Athlete of the Year, and others. As nomination forms are received and honors are earned, they will be published and distributed as necessary. The institution will make every effort to make sure that eligible, deserving student-athletes and coaches are recognized.
