_____ **Qualifier [Bylaw 14.5.4.1]**

- Minimum of one full-time semester/quarter in residence at the two-year college (excluding summer sessions);
- Average of 12 hours of transferable degree credit at the certifying institution per semester/quarter attended, and
- Cumulative minimum grade-point average of 2.000 (see Bylaw 14.5.4.6.3.2 and Part II-C above).

_____ **Qualifier - Discontinued/Nonsponsored Sport Exception (Bylaw 14.5.4.7.1)**

A qualifier may be immediately eligible even if he/she does not meet the above conditions if the student:

- Changed institutions in order to continue participating in a sport because the student's original two-year college dropped the sport from its intercollegiate program or never sponsored the sport on the intercollegiate level while the student was in attendance at that institution;
- Never attended any other collegiate institution that offered intercollegiate competition in that sport, and
- Earned a minimum 2.0 GPA at the two-year college (see 14.5.4.6.3.2).

_____ **Partial/NonQualifiers - ALL SPORTS [Bylaws 14.5.4.2 and 14.5.4.3]**

A student who was not a qualifier is eligible for institutional financial aid, practice and competition during the first academic year in residence only if the student has:

- *Completed two-year college graduation requirements prior to reporting for practice/enrolling at SPC;
- Type of degree: _____
- Completed satisfactorily a minimum of 48 semester or 72 quarter hours of transferable degree credit acceptable toward any baccalaureate degree program at the certifying institution with a minimum cumulative grade-point average of 2.000 (see 14.5.4.6.3.2);
- ** Not more than 18 semester or 27 quarter hours of the transferable degree credit was earned in summer terms;
- **Not more than 9 semester or 13.5 quarter hours of the transferable degree credit was earned in the summer term(s) immediately prior to the transfer, and
- Attended a two-year college as a full-time student for at least three semesters or four quarters (excluding summer terms and cannot be satisfied in one academic year per 14.5.4.2.2).

*At least 25% of credit hours utilized to fulfill the degree requirements must be earned at the two-year college awarding the degree (Bylaw 14.5.4.6.1).
