DEFINITIONS OF COACHING CATEGORIES

Head or Assistant Coach

A head or assistant coach is any coach who is designated by the institution's athletics department to perform coaching duties and who serves in that capacity on a volunteer or paid basis. This individual can recruit off-campus, if certified by passing the NCAA coaches certification exam.

Undergraduate Assistant Coach

An undergraduate student-coach is any coach who is an undergraduate student-athlete who has exhausted his or her eligibility in the sport or has become injured to the point that he or she is unable to practice or compete ever again, and who meets the following additional criteria:

- (a) Is enrolled at the institution at which he or she participated in intercollegiate athletics;
- (b) Is participating as a student-coach within the five-year eligibility period (see Bylaw 14.2);
- (c) Is completing the requirements for his or her baccalaureate degree;
- (d) Is a full-time student, unless during his or her final semester or quarter of the baccalaureate program, per Bylaw 14.1.6.2.1.3;
- (e) Is receiving no compensation or remuneration from the institution other than the financial aid that could be received as a student-athlete and expenses incurred on road trips that are received by individual team members; and (Revised: 1/9/96)
- (f) Is not involved in contacting and evaluating prospective student-athletes off campus or scouting opponents off campus.

Volunteer Coach

In sports other than football and basketball, a volunteer coach is any coach who does not receive compensation or remuneration from the institution's athletics department or any organization funded in whole or in part by the athletics department or that is involved primarily in the promotion of the institution's athletics program (e.g., booster club, athletics foundation association). The following provisions shall apply: (Revised: 1/10/92 effective 8/1/92, Revised: 4/26/01 effective 8/1/01)

- (a) The individual is prohibited from contacting and evaluating prospective student-athletes off campus or from scouting opponents off campus. (Revised: 1/16/93, 1/11/94)
- (b) The individual may receive a maximum of two complimentary tickets to home athletics contests in the coach's sport. (Revised: 1/16/93)
