



IMPORTANT INFORMATION Below FOR ALL FRESHMEN STUDENT-ATHLETES regarding the NCAA Initial eligibility center!

For those students that are going to be participating on one of the Saint Peter's College athletic teams or any Division I institution, you have to be a Qualifier with the NCAA Initial Eligibility Center.

REGISTER EARLY!!!! There are two components that make-up the NCAA Initial Eligibility Center. A prospective student-athlete must have both their academics and amateurism certified in order to be eligible for practice, competition and receive athletically related financial aid.

Below is a quick registration guide:

Quick Registration Guide (ONLINE Registration is required!):

Step 1: Go to www.ncaaclearinghouse.net.

Step 2: Follow the link for Prospective Student-Athlete.

Step 3: Click on Domestic Student Release Form or Foreign Student Release Form.

Step 4: Register by putting in ALL required information and answering ALL questions.

Step 5: Have your official high school transcripts (from each high school you attended) mailed to the clearinghouse by your high school guidance counselor.

Step 6: Have your official test scores mailed to the clearinghouse by the appropriate testing board.

Step 7: Check the clearinghouse Web site on a weekly basis to see your status.

If a prospective student-athlete is deemed a **NON-QUALIFIER** (or his/her status is still pending) he/she will not be allowed to practice, compete, receive athletically related financial aid or be affiliated with any athletically related activity for his/her first year of residence at Saint Peter's College.
