



**IMPORTANT INFORMATION Below FOR ALL
Transfer student-athletes regarding the
NCAA CLEARINGHOUSE!**

Any student-athlete that is a **two-year** or **four-year college transfer** that is coming from an institution that is NOT a NCAA division I or II institution must register with the NCAA Clearinghouse and complete the amateurism certification.

Below is a quick registration guide:

Quick Registration Guide (ONLINE Registration is required!):

Step 1: Go to www.ncaaclearinghouse.net.

Step 2: Follow the link for Prospective Student-Athlete.

Step 3: Click on Domestic Student Release Form or Foreign Student Release Form.

Step 4: Register by putting in ALL required information and answering ALL questions related to the amateurism certification.

Step 5: Check the clearinghouse Web site on a weekly basis to see your status.

A transfer prospective student-athlete must be certified academically through the institution's athletics department in accordance with NCAA regulations. A transfer prospective student-athlete cannot practice, compete or receive athletically related financial aid until their academics and amateurism is certified per NCAA regulations.
